On behalf of the Audubon Society of New Hampshire, it gives me great pleasure to endorse the proposal by Friends of the Sandwich Range to extend the Sandwich Range Wilderness and the creation of the Sandwich Notch National Historic Area.

As you know, the mission of the Audubon Society of New Hampshire (ASNH) is to protect and enhance the natural environment for wildlife and for people. We at ASNH believe that the Friends' proposal is consistent with that mission. Wilderness areas serve to protect wildlife habitat long-term and enhance biodiversity by allowing the forest to reach a mature state that does not occur in actively managed areas.
